Our Aims & Objections

We encourage and motivate our staff to enjoy and embrace the hotel's CSR policy and to assist wherever possible in implementing ways in which to keep the property as green as possible.

Waste Management

- Recycling programs are in place throughout the hotel including water bottles, Dry Cleaning coat hangers, paper, delivery boxes and printer toners
- We use eco-conscious cleaning products including e-cloths
- Provide newspapers to guests only on request to avoid wastage and recycle spare copies
- Liquid soaps are used to prevent wastage
- The Mandeville Hotel will always email contracts, confirmations etc where possible to reduce paper use
- Online brochures are available and hard copies are printed on recycled paper

Water Conservation

- Guests are offered the choice of re-using their towels
- Dual flush toilets are in place to save water
- Tap water is available in the bar and restaurant upon request
- A number of guest rooms are fitted with separate walk in showers to encourage guests to take a shower instead of a bath resulting in water saving

Air Quality

- Low volatile organic compound materials are used, such as paints etc
- We provide information on local public transportation for guests
- Staff are encouraged to use public transport or cycle to work

Energy Efficiency

- Vingcard systems are used throughout the hotel bedrooms meaning that when a guest leaves the room, the lights switch off automatically
- Staff always ensure that office and back of house lights and computers are switched off when they are not in use
- Natural light is used wherever possible to minimize lighting

Eco-Cuisine – Food & Beverage

- Linen napkins are used instead of paper ones
- Menus produced internally will be printed on recycled paper stock
- Organic food and Fair-Trade beverages are used in the deVigne Bar & deVille Restaurant
- Seafood choices are sustainable
- Vegetarian options are always available
- Food produce is seasonal and locally sourced to reduce air-miles
- Free range produce is used such as Chicken, Eggs etc
